



## **General Information**

Quirindi Retirement Homes Limited is a community owned not for profit organization engaged in the provision of Quality Aged Care to the Ageing population of Quirindi District and wider community. Quirindi Retirement Homes Limited is located within the Liverpool Plains Shire Council. The shire has a population of 7,540 people with the major towns of Quirindi and Werris Creek servicing 8 surrounding villages.

The Quirindi area is experiencing significant growth and currently has several major projects in operation: A \$10m softwood timber processing facility, a 1million tonne per annum Coal Mine near Werris Creek, several rural and residential subdivisions and the granting to BHP/Billiton an Exploration License to explore the Caroon Coal Reserves.

Location: Quirindi is located approximately 45mins south of Tamworth, 2hrs north of the Hunter Valley, 3hrs north of Newcastle, 4hrs north of Sydney and 7hrs south of Brisbane.

Education: Quirindi is well catered for with an Early Childhood Centre, Preschool, Public High School, Public and Catholic Primary Schools, TAFE and Community College.

Facilities: The renovated Royal Theatre has regular live performances by visiting artists as well as regularly showing recent movies. Many different sports are represented in Quirindi at both junior and senior level.
